Dear Mr. Record:

I write to follow-up my April 14, 2015 letter in the context of Governor Brown's Executive Order B-29-15, State of Emergency due to drought and the recent Metropolitan Water District (MWD) water delivery reduction plan.

It is clear that, as well as smart conservation, we must search for new water supply sources. It is for this reason I wrote to you in support of the Cadiz Valley Water Conservation, Recovery and Storage Project and its potential to deliver water to 100,000 families over fifty years. I am aware that MWD-southern California and MWD-Orange County water providers have reserved Cadiz Project supplies. As you and your board members move to apply the Governor's Executive Order, I request that you vigorously pursue new water supply sources as well as employing smart water use and reuse operations.

During the coming months, it is anticipated that you and your board members will review the Cadiz Valley Water Conservation, Recovery and Storage Project. May I express my support for this project and urge your favorable consideration.
